## **Computer Corner**

## **Prevent Losing Contact With Your Post**

Each month we find that several members have changed their email address and have not let the Post know. The emails come back as "Delivery Failure". This creates a lot of unnecessary lost time for the Adjutant and/or Webmaster as they try to contact the members. Many times, the phone number has also been changed. Consequently, the affected member no longer receives the newsletter and other Post announcements. So, if you are planning to change your email, phone number, or address, then please contact the Adjutant at 760-754-9633 or adjutant@legionpost146.org. Alternately, you can update your information at mylegion.org. If you do not have an account yet, you can create one at the Log In screen.

#### **Upgrade to Windows 10 Free**

By now you have probably heard that Microsoft support for Windows 7 ends on January 14, 2020. That means no more monthly security updates to the operating system. Yes, you can still use the computer, however, you will be more at risk for cybercrimes even though you have up-to-date anti-virus and anti-malware software running.

Being a Windows 7 die-hard, I decided it was time to upgrade my computers to Windows 10. Not wanting to pay over \$125 each for the Windows 10 operating system, I found a way to accomplish the upgrade at no cost. Following the instructions in the link below, I was pleasantly surprised as to how easy it was. All my programs and settings were transferred from Windows 7 to 10, and the interface is almost identical to Windows 7, right down to the same Desktop background. I did not have to reinstall any of my 24 software programs (by the way these are called Apps in Windows 10). It took about 1.5 hours for Windows to automatically accomplish the upgrade. After that I spent another 15 minutes turning off App access to private data in Settings.

A check of license Activation in Windows settings shows my computers now have valid Windows 10 licenses. This is a legal upgrade from Microsoft. The below link explains that the old Windows 7 license converts to a new Windows license.

There is one downside in my case. I have two printers, a 5-year-old wireless Brother All-in-One and an 11-year-old Canon inkjet printer connected to one computer by a USB cable. Unfortunately, Canon did not update the driver for use by Windows 10, so that printer no longer works. The wireless Brother still works fine which is okay in my case. If you have an old printer or other peripheral, then you may want to check the manufacturer's website to see if it is compatible.
