To our North County Military Community and to our Friends,

In 1986, local Pearl Harbor Survivors formed a chapter of the national Pearl Harbor Survivors Association. One of its charter members was Joe Walsh (USMC, 3d Defense Battalion). Chapter 31 once numbered 146 members--145 sailors, soldiers, and Marines plus one Army nurse. Today, two members remain with us--Joe Walsh and George Coburn (*USS Oklahoma*). Joe will be 101 years old next March. George recently turned 100.

When Pearl Harbor Survivors formed a national organization in 1958, its charter identified several purposes for the group. Two stand out as particularly relevant as we organize for this year's December 7th ceremony--"to keep alive the memory of our Brothers who died in the attack" and "to perpetuate the memory and history of our dead." If Joe Walsh's health permits, he will once again be at the Little Fishing Pier this coming December 7th, as will George Coburn.

Please join them as we honor the 2,403 soldiers, sailors, and Marines who paid the ultimate price seventy-eight years ago.

December 7th this year falls on a Saturday. We have again reserved the Little Fishing Pier in Oceanside as the site of Chapter 31's ceremony. It will begin at 9:30 a.m., but plan to arrive several minutes before that so that everyone is "in place" at nine-thirty.
