We at VANC would like to thank each and every one of you for taking the time to discuss 2019. Here is what was discussed and what was decided.

Annual Membership Dues \$500.00.

• Dues may be paid as a one-time payment, monthly or quarterly.

The decision of "how' payment will be made must be decided and VANC notified by Monday 4 February.

Membership Includes:

• ONE monthly general meeting and if group wishes, ONE monthly board or executive session.

If the membership group does not already have a monthly date to hold a board or executive session, the membership group leader needs to arrange the date/time with the VANC Event Coordinator (Suzanne).

• VANC website presence with link to your page to help recruit to grow your membership. You will be asked to provide content to create your membership page, if your membership group has a website a link to your site will be available.

Membership Notification:

 Once the membership group notifies VANC that they accept the terms and conditions, the board of directors will vote to accept the membership group. The membership group will be sent by email the status of membership within ONE week of the original notification.

Fundraising in the VANC building

Flat fee of \$200 for using the La Jolla Room If the membership group decides to have a large fund raiser in the Oceanside Room a minimum fee of \$500 will apply. If the membership decides to use the bar (bartender charge will apply) all bar revenue collected by VANC can't in ANY way be shared per Alcohol Beverage Control (ABC) rules. A revenue share of your fundraising activities up to \$500 will be credited to your room.

There will be a 75/25 split with the 25% of profit going to VANC

Extras available for fundraising:
Bartender (1 per every 100 guests) \$20 hour (starts 1hour prior for set up)
Security (1 per every 100 guests) \$27 hour (ends 1 hour after event to clear)
Linens: Tablecloth (white only) \$3.00 each Napkins \$0.85 each (color choices)
In-House Catering: (no minimum) prices vary
