This year we are sending six boys to Boy's State. The Post will pay for four and Frank Z one. I will donate \$100.00 for the 6<sup>th</sup> and am seeking donations for the rest. We are not sure the amount for each boy yet, but about \$500.00 per boy.



I wanted to introduce my organization to you if you are not familiar with us. We are a nonprofit located in Oceanside that provides low cost transportation services to seniors, disabled, and Veterans throughout San Diego County. We charge a low fare between \$2.50 and \$10 each way based on mileage. From now until the end of the year we are offering **Veterans 1 free roundtrip ride per week**. In addition, one companion can also ride for free. We accept reservations up to seven days in advance and request at least one day notice. Our drivers provide service between 7am and 7pm, subject to availability.
