Post 146 Adjutant's Report

Happy October Legionnaires! This month our membership committee will be contacting those members that are in arrears for this fiscal year dues (2018) and for the upcoming 2019 dues. As we appreciate our members that have kept their dues current, we still have approximately 130 of our members that did not renew for 2018 and with that cannot renew for 2019. We also have 280 members whose 2019 dues are not paid. Our goal is to have 100% of our 2018 dues and over 95% of our membership dues collected by 12/31/18.

The committee will be mailing out reminder letters this week for both years. Please respond promptly as to your reply. Post dues are \$45 dollars of which \$33.50 goes to National and Department (State). We only keep \$11.50 locally here at the Post.

If you are not aware, membership dues have been the largest source of income for our post over the last few years. These funds are crucial for the operation of our Post, to not only meet our basic annual obligations, but to put on the programs we sponsor each year. But it is not enough!

The Post needs your help in ideas for fundraising to better support our Post. We want to bring more programs on line, as well as support the ones that we support now. Here are just a few; Americanism – Boys Oratorical, Boys State, School Medals, Flags, Scouting and hopefully Baseball.
